Parents' Night

Parents' Night will be held on Friday, July 16th (Session 1) and Friday July 30th (Session 2) at 7:00 PM. Parents' Night is an opportunity for all the parents to come and see what the campers have learned throughout the two weeks. We encourage all parents to come for this short evening program. Camp will still end at 4:00 PM, however, any camper that would like to stay at the temple until the evening program is welcome to do so. They will be shown a movie and will receive snacks. The dress code is Indian formal so we ask that campers have these clothes with them to change if they are staying after. It is quite likely that the Parent's Night will be a virtual event for attendees. We will inform you at a later time as per updates from the Safety & Security Committee.

Details about Online Camp - NOT APPLICABLE

If camp remains online, the dates of the sessions will remain the same, but camp will most likely only occur in the mornings from 9-12. Campers will be able to participate in morning puja, learn sanskrit and philosophy, and enjoy a daily special activity. These will occur over a platform such as Google Meet or Zoom.
